Highway Superintendent: Alex Hodge: present

Alex stated that bids are out for sand, he stated that Callahan is \$12.90 per ton, He also stated that Payne Construction has it for \$6.00 per yard ($$1 \frac{1}{4}$ yard per ton).

Alex asked what the Town Board wanted to do for sand.

The Town Board agreed that this is up to Alex to decide where he gets the sand.

The Town has received used oil from residents for the new oil burner.

There is one truck down, they are waiting for parts.

Alex asked about the two trucks that are for surplus, putting them on the Auctions International website.

It costs \$ 15.00 for the pictures. The Town Board agreed on this, they suggested putting a minimum bid for each one.

Town Supervisor: Ronda Winn:

Report submitted.

Supervisor Winn stated that she asked Bookkeeper Brynley Wilcox about getting her Budget Officer pay and Brynley stated that she could get anytime she wanted if the Town Board approves.

The Town Board approved her to get her salary for the Budget officer.

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It was discussed about the Solar Law that Council Chadwick Nower had presented a few months back, The Town Board agreed to have the Town Attorney look at it and then proceed with this. Council Chadwick Nower states that the Solar Company should have responsibilities. And this needs to be stated in the Local Law.

Council Chadwick Nower feels that the Town Attorney doesn't need to do our Solar Local Law.

The Town Board feels the Town Attorney needs to draft this Local Law.

Supervisor Winn feels we need to take the advice of the Madison County Planning Department regarding Solar Local Law.

Then the Town Board feels the Solar Company needs to be held responsible for the batteries and maintained in any shape or form.

The Town Board wants to make sure that there are not any solar farms that have been abandon and inactive, They want it worded that if inactive or keep it active.

Code Enforcement Officer Aaron camp stated that Solar permits are just like cell towers when they are no longer used. They just can't leave them there. They have a certain amount of time and really should be operating permits continually, so they don't want to keep getting fed with an operating permit, which comes with visual inspection, and everything must be kept up. If it becomes in disrepair and they discontinue use after a year. This gives us control to say if not using then take it down.

They must return land to original state, The state calls this a scarf.

The town could do a limitation to this law, have it a maximum mega -watt production. That way we won't get huge Solar Farms.

Aaron also stated that putting some size on the land in the Local Law, He stated that we can do this. He stated that there is nothing that the Solar Company can do or even the state can't override this.

This gives the town some say throughout this process. This would have to go through the Planning board for things such as landscaping, fencing, etc.
