RESOLUTON NO. 68-2021

AMENDING 2022 PRELIMINARY TOWN OF LEBANON BUDGET

WHEREAS Town of Lebanon board members have had a chance to review and discuss salary requests and increases for elected and appointed officials for the 2022 final town budget, NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Lebanon Town Board approves amending the proposed preliminary 2022 Town of Lebanon Town Budget to reflect the following changes: Salary increases for 2022

General Fund

Increase A 3620.1 Code Enforcement PSI from \$\$7,532 to \$7,909

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Increase A 8010.1 Zoning, PSI from \$3,113 to \$3,269

Total Code Enforcement officer salary increase from \$10,645 to \$11,178

Increase A1410.1 Town Clerk, PSI from \$11,904 to \$12,500

Increase A 1330.1 Tax Collector, PSI from \$3,045 to \$3,198

Increase A5101.1 Superintendent of Highways, PSI from \$60,364 to \$62,865

Total Salary increases = \$3,782

Increase General Fund tax levy from \$9,484 to \$13,266

Amend General Fund expenditures budget to increase from \$297,499 to \$301,281.

Highway Fund

Increase the pay of all full-time highway employees by \$1.00 per hour effective Jan. 1, 2022

Increase the following budget lines by the following amounts for the 2022 budget:"

DA 5110.1, General Repairs PS from \$80,000 to \$83,333

DA 5142.1, Snow Removal PSI from \$75,000 to \$78,333

DA 5148.1, Other Govt. Services, PS from \$75,000 to \$78,333

Increase the Highway Fund total budget from \$747,700 to \$757,699

Increase Highway Fund tax levy from \$357,200 to \$367, 199
